Is combining work and family possible for fathers? - Webinar 7.10.2022

How do fathers cope with balancing work and family life? Researcher **Emilia Kangas's** <u>doctoral dissertation</u> shows that organizations typically fail to equally support men's parenthood. It is still assumed that family has no effect on fathers' work. <u>MiB's member survey</u> conducted in June also shows that most workplaces still do not really encourage fathers to take family leave.

In this webinar, you will hear Emilia Kangas talk about father-friendly management and her study results. The presentation will be translated simultaneously to English for this webinar. Kangas has studied discourses of fatherhood in leadership and organizations at the University of Jyväskylä.
